

Zeit Usability Test Record

 - 1. Home x 1
 - 2. Destination x 1
 - 3. Sign up page x 2
 - 4. Search result x 1
 - 5. Individual product x 1
 - 6. Check out process x 4
- Tasks:
 - Task 1: When you look at the website, what's the website telling you?
 - Task 2: Find all destinations Zeit offers.
 - Task 3: Perform sign-up?
 - Task 4: Search for a dinosaur-related trip.

- Task 5: In search results, sort the results from lowest to highest.
- Task 6: Filter only the destinations which have 4 stars and above?
- Task 7: Find what you can do, and where you will stay at this destination.
- Task 8: Complete the booking process.

3. Test finding conclusion

Every participant completed the task directly, without redo. Two participants are confused between menu "Destinations" and "Locations", I believe we will need to rethink the name "Location" to be replaced with "Zeit near me" or "Our departure location", etc. Also, in the HERO section, we could emphasize "Time Travel" more, to let our business advantage (Time Travel) stand out from other tourist websites.
